MONTREAL

Montréal is the second biggest French city in the world. It is a city of contrasts with Old-Montreal, the modern districts of the downtown and the underground city full of cafés, restaurants, shops and movie theaters. Walk to Mont-Royal for a breathtaking view of Montréal. Enjoy a guided bus tour of the city and visit the Montréal Tower Observatory. A funicular-type elevator brings visitors to the Observatory located in the highest inclined tower in the world.

QUEBEC CITY

Quebec is distinctively European; a place of mellowed stone buildings, horse-drawn carriages and narrow winding streets. Experience Quebec City on a guided walking tour and visit: Place d'Armes, the Basilica, City Hall, Parliament, Plains of Abraham, the Citadelle, Quartier Petit-Champlain and Place-Royale. Visit the Traditional Huron-Wendat site. This village is located in a natural environment, it will enable you to familiarise yourself with the first nation's traditions, past and present. Enjoy a Huron dance and song show.
