### ATHENS

Explore this marvelous city, the "Cradle of Civilization". We visit the Acropolis and stop at the Areopagus where we read St. Paul's message concerning the "Unknown God".

### CRUISE THE GREEK ISLANDS

Our first stop is Mykonos, a vibrant island with its colorful harbour, all-white houses and windmills. Travelling on to Kusadasi Turkey, once known as one of the richest cities in Asia Minor, we take in the breathtaking ruins of Ephesus. We also visit:

Patmos Island, home to the Monastery of St John the Theologian and the Cave of the Apocalypse.

Crete, an island with an exquisite 1000 kilometer-long coastline dotted with numerous coves. Santorini, one of the most magical islands of Greece with its breathtaking views and fabulous sunsets.
