LONDON

Begin with an orientation tour of London's West End, passing Buckingham Palace including the changing of the guard (if held), Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Downing Street, Westminster Abbey, Piccadilly Circus and the London Eye. In addition, you will visit the Tower Bridge, St Paul's, the Tower of London and the Crown Jewels.

CAMBRIDGE

Travel to Cambridge which has been a celebrated university Town since 1209. Tour of Cambridge includes a visit to King's College and the Chapel - one of the most important examples of late medieval architecture. Take a 'Punt' (river cruise in traditional boaters) along the river Cam.
